REQUEST

Public Works Department, Technical Services Division, is requesting the City Commission to award Continuing Services Contract to Climate Control Mechanical Services, 2695 NW 4th Street, Ocala, Florida 34475 in accordance with Chapter 30 of the City Code, for as-needed HVAC repairs to equipment and controls, for a one (1) year term with three (1) year renewals, and to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the contracts and provide an effective date.

PURPOSE

A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued for Continuing Services Contracts for HVAC repairs, maintenance and control Services, and five (5) firms responded. The City's Selection Committee convened on February23, 2017 to review the Proposals received in response to the referenced RFP, and scored those proposals in accordance with the evaluation criteria published in the RFP. The City Manager selected the two short listed firms on the Committee's recommended short list, and staff negotiated the contract. Contractors selected are listed below.
