<p>VISION PLAN/STRATEGIC PLANNING INITIATIVE: <u>Economic Development: Build on our community's economic strength while preserving our unique environment and improving the quality of life of all our citizens. Infrastructure: To ensure that the citizens of Daytona Beach have the services and infrastructure needed to maintain and enhance their quality of life.</u></p>			
<p>BACKGROUND: <u>This is a request to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a revised Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). This agreement will replace the current Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement executed in 2002. The implementation of this agreement is in the best interests of the City of Daytona Beach by providing additional FDOT reimbursement for various traffic signal components such as the telecommunication links between traffic signals and the Traffic Management Center located in Public Works. The revised reimbursement amount would be \$228,000.00 versus \$133,000.00 under the current agreement. Additionally yearly increases will be based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI).</u></p>
