

RESOLUTION NO. 17-206

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THOMPSON CONSULTING SERVICES, LLC, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONSULTANTS' COMPETITIVE NEGOTIATION ACT AND CHAPTER 30, CITY CODE, TO PROVIDE AS-NEEDED DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES FOR A THREE-YEAR TERM WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR TWO ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR TERMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposals for city-wide disaster debris monitoring and related services, in accordance with the Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act ("CCNA"), § 287.055, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 30 of the City Code; and


WHEREAS, proposals were received and reviewed in accordance with the CCNA and Chapter 30, City Code; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Public Works Director recommends approval of the Continuing Professional Services Contracts with Thompson Consulting Services, LLC, for as-needed debris monitoring services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Continuing Professional Services Contract with Thompson Consulting Services, LLC (No. 0117-0960), for a three-year term with options to renew for two one-year terms, with the scope of services and compensation to be negotiated and mutually agreed upon for each project prior to authorization by the City. A copy of the Contract in substantially final form is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
