REQUEST

Utilities Department requests the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the purchase of one (1) bypass pump from the Florida Sheriff's Association Bid FSA17-VEH 15.0 specification 076 with options from Thompson Pump and Manufacturing, 4620 City Center Dr., Port Orange, FL 32129, in the amount of \$54,980.00.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this board item is to purchase a bypass pump for Lift Station 4 replacement.

CONSIDERATION

The requested bypass pump has been budgeted and is part of the overall construction plan to provide backup power for all new sanitary lift stations coming on line. The new Lift Station 4 is located at 550 Division St.

FUNDING

Funds are available in the Renewal and Replacement 8% Fund 428-610000-536-565000-611524.
