Re: Amendment to the Agreement between the City of Daytona Beach and Technomedia Solutions, LLC

Request for City Commission approval of an amendment to a Contract between the City and Technomedia Solutions, 4545 36th Street, Orlando FL 32811, a Florida limited liability company. The Contract was entered into for the installation and maintenance of a Scoreboard System at the Municipal Stadium and was approved by Ord. 14-261. The Municipal Stadium Scoreboard System Warranty with Technomedia Solutions, required for maintaining functionality and aesthetics of the system, expires December 18, 2017.

The proposed amendment extends the agreement to December 18, 2019, a period of two years, in the amount of \$15,000 per year, and provides Reset-Repair, Quarterly Preventative Maintenance, and As-Needed repair services by manufacturer approved technicians. Under the terms of the amendment, the City shall have the option to extend the warranty period for an additional one year.

The Stadium Scoreboard System screens frequently require LED module replacements and color and brightness calibrations. At the present time, the Scoreboard System is not functioning in accordance with the warranty provided in the current contract.

Reset-Repair Services are required immediately, will include the same services as preventive maintenance services, and are required to ensure the Scoreboard System is fully operational. Time is of the essence as to the Reset-Repair Services, they are to be completed on or before December 13, 2017.

The extended warranty will cover all components of the Scoreboard System including the video signal processing equipment, equipment installed in the control room, and the PA/Audio equipment. Quarterly Preventative Maintenance will commence on or around the first week in March, 2018 and occur approximately every 90 days thereafter.

Additionally, for non-warranty services, the City will pay Technomedia at the rate of \$125.00 per hour billed in three hour increments. The City will also pay reasonable shipping costs for all repair or replacement materials required as part of a service or repair.

This is a sole source purchase, due to the existing contract with Technomedia LLC, since Technomedia is the original installer, and since Technomedia possesses institutional knowledge of the systems.

The Acting Cultural & Leisure Services Director recommends approval of the amendment.
