## REQUEST

Public Works is requesting that the City Commission approve a Resolution for Work Authorization No. 8 under Continuing Services Contract 2006–21 with Sea Diversified, Inc. 151 N. W. 1rst Ave., Delray Beach, Fl. 33444, in the amount not to exceed \$59,867.20.

### **PURPOSE**

This Agenda item provides for an updated As-Built / General Condition Survey of the Main Street Pier. This survey will be used in the analysis to identify any deficiencies in the Pier structure and in the development of Capital Improvements Program (CIP) projects to help preserve this structure.

## **CONSIDERATIONS**

The Main Street Pier is a Historic Structure that is a key feature of the beachside area and also houses the Joe's Crab Shack restaurant. The Main Street Pier is over 70 years old and located in a harsh marine environment. The proposed General Condition Survey is needed to help develop the CIP projects required to preserve the structure.

### **FUNDING**

Funding is available in the Pier Improvements Fund Account No. 480-00000-572-565000-601410 in the amount of \$59,867.20.

### RECOMMENDATIONS

Deputy Public Works Director is recommending that the City Commission approve a Resolution for Work Authorization No. 8 under Continuing Services Contract 2006-21 with Sea Diversified, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$59,867.20.
