**SUBJECT:** Sixth Amendment – East Volusia Fire-Rescue/EMS Interlocal Agreement - Extension

## REQUEST

The Fire Department respectfully requests City Commission approval by resolution for the *Sixth Amendment of the East Volusia Fire-Rescue and Emergency Medical Services Automatic Aid and Closest Unit Response System* interlocal agreement.

## PURPOSE

The intent of this interlocal agreement is to provide mutual assistance in case of a fire, medical, or other emergency in order to bring an emergency under control in a timely manner or to provide back-up response in the requesting party's jurisdiction or providing assistance in a requesting party's jurisdiction.

## CONSIDERATION

The current interlocal agreement is set to expire on September 30, 2018. The sixth amendment to the agreement allows for a four (4) year extension through September 30, 2022. There are no fees associated with this agreement.

## FUNDING

No funding associated with this request.

## RECOMMENDATION

The Fire Department respectfully requests City Commission approval by resolution for the *Sixth Amendment of the East Volusia Fire-Rescue and Emergency Medical Services Automatic Aid and Closest Unit Response System* interlocal agreement. For the Mayor and City Manager to execute the agreement by signature. Final signed agreement shall be recorded by the Volusia County Clerk of Courts.
