



BACKGROUND: <u>Resolution approving the Sixth Amendment of the Interlocal Agreement for East Volusia Local Government Fire-Rescue and Emergency Medical Services Automatic Aid and Closest Unit Response System. The current interlocal agreement to provide continuous fire-rescue and EMS services in times of need is set to expire on September 30, 2018. The sixth amendment allows for a 4-year extension of the existing agreement until September 30, 2022. There is a no fee associated with the reciprocal agreement. Partnering governments: Ormond Beach, Holly Hill, South Daytona, Daytona Beach Shores, Port Orange, Ponce Inlet, New Smyrna Beach, Edgewater.</u>
