UPDATE: The city's building official condemned the structure this afternoon. Due to structural damage caused by the fire and the amount of water used to extinguish the blaze, the structure is in imminent danger of collapse. A demolition contractor has been retained by the city and emergency demo work will begin tomorrow. All lanes of Orange Avenue, from Beach Street to Palmetto, will be closed until the structure is razed.

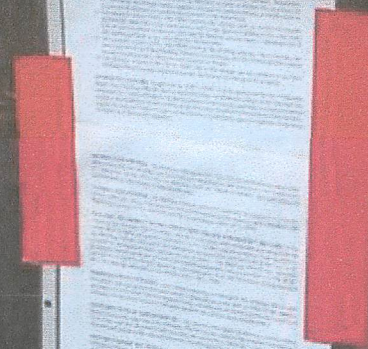
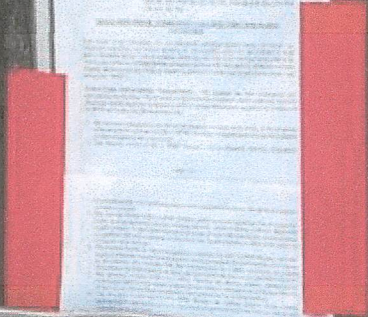

Subject: Fire at Bayview Hotel on Orange Avenue

Commissioners,

The Daytona Beach Fire Department responded overnight to a structure fire at the Bayview Hotel located at 124 Orange Ave. As of this email, the fire is ongoing and units from Port Orange and Volusia County are assisting in the efforts to bring this intense fire under control. The fire is contained to the specific address and has not spread to neighboring structures.

Thirty-six occupants staying at the approximately 40-room hotel were evacuated but not injured.



Orange Avenue from Ridgewood to Beach Street is closed to through traffic, as well as access to Orange Avenue from Palmetto and Beach Street. City Hall remains open and public access is available through the front doors on the second floor.
