BACKGROUND: Resolution authorizing the acceptance of Continuing General Municipal Professional Engineering Services Contracts with Lassiter Transportation Group, Inc. (LTG), 1450 West Granada Blvd, Suite 2, Ormond Beach, FL, Parker Mynchenberg and Associates (PMA), 1729 Ridgewood Avenue, Holly Hill, Florida 32117, and The RAM Professional Group, 8298 Bayberry Road, Suite 100, Jacksonville, FL.

The City advertised a request for proposals on February 1, 2018 for Continuing General Municipal Professional Engineering Services Contracts. Nine (9) Engineering Consultants submitted by February 23, 2018 in response to the request for proposals (RFP). The Selection Committee recommended contract negotiations with Lassiter Transportation Group, Inc., Parker Mynchenberg and Associates (PMA), and The RAM Professional Group. This is a 2 year contract with three renewal options of one year each.

No funding is necessary to award the Continuing General Municipal Professional Engineering Services Contracts.
