



VISION PLAN/STRATEGIC PLANNING INITIATIVE: Quality of Life-Public Safety

BACKGROUND: The City of Daytona Beach Police Department Victim Advocate Position is funded primarily by the Florida Office of Attorney General, Victim of Crime Act Program, (VOCA) funding in the amount of \$43,613.00, with matching funds coming from the law enforcement trust fund in the amount of \$10,903.00, for a total of \$54,516.00 to fund the continuation of the police department's VOCA Program; and to authorize the City Manager or his Designee to execute any agreement relating to this grant application. This application has passed the VOCA office technical review and subsequent required revision and has been approved by the VOCA office for award.
