
VISION PLAN/STRATEGIC PLANNING INITIATIVE: This item meets the Infrastructure aspect of Visioning Initiatives - To ensure that the citizens of Daytona Beach have the services and infrastructure needed to maintain and enhance their quality of life.

BACKGROUND: Request for City Commission approval to purchase a floating license of Innovyze InfoSWMM Wastewater Collection System software, including 10,000 links, and the first year of software maintenance from vendor # 101285 Innovyze Inc., 6720 SW Macadam Ave. Suite 150, Portland OR 97219, in the amount of \$29,380. Carollo Engineers Inc. was chosen as the City's Engineering Consultant for developing a Wastewater Master Plan pursuant to Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 0418-0680. Carollo Engineers recommends the City implement InfoSWMM as its wastewater hydraulic software for modeling gravity sewer and force main networks. The City already owns a license to InfoWater, a similar software used for modeling potable water systems, which is made by the same company as InfoSWMM. Efficiencies are expected to be gained from staff training on and using similar software to model water and wastewater.
