


PUBLIC HEARING - Members of the general public may speak and ask questions on the proposed millage rate and the FY 2018/19 budget.</u></p> <p><u>3. Resolution of the Daytona Beach Downtown Development Authority adopting an ad valorem property tax millage rate of 1.0000 (\$1.0000 per \$1,000 of assessed taxable value). This is the rate utilized in the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and is a 27.50% tax increase from the rolled back rate of 0.7843.</u></p> <p><u>4. Resolution adopting the Budget for the fiscal year October 1, 2018, to September 30, 2019; prescribing estimated Revenue Sources of \$ 266,032 and setting forth Operating Expenditures, Capital Expenditures, and Transfers of \$ 266,032.</u></p>
