REQUEST

Public Works is requesting that the City Commission approve a Resolution for Work Authorization No. 16 under Continuing Services Contract 2010-018-CA with Cardno, 380 Park Place Boulevard, Suite 300, Clearwater, Florida 33759, in an amount not to exceed \$81,660.

PURPOSE

This Agenda item provides for four quarters of Phase One Remedial Action activities as per the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) approved remedial action plan, two semi-annual sampling events, a meeting with the FDEP, and FDEP reporting. A Copy of the Cardno continuing services contract has been included in this Agenda Package.

CONSIDERATION

The Clyde Morris Boulevard Brownfield site has the presence of a free product contaminant covering approximately 1.7 acres. This project is in the initial stages of contaminate remediation and over the last four quarters approximately 6,770 gallons of free product contaminant was recovered. Work for this project to be completed as further described in the attached Cardno proposal dated September 11, 2018.

FUNDING

Funding for Work Authorization No. 16 in the amount of \$81,660 will be provided from the Brownfield Site Rehabilitation Solid Waste Capital Project Account No. 430-600000-534-549000-631409.

RECOMMENDATION

Deputy Public Works Director is recommending that the City Commission approve a Resolution for Work Authorization No. 16 under Continuing Services Contract 2010-018-CA with Cardno, 380 Park Place Boulevard, Suite 300, Clearwater, Florida 33759, in an amount not to exceed \$81,660.
