RE: Commission Action to Amend the City’s 2018-2019  
State Legislative Priorities List

At the December 17, 2018 Volusia Legislative Delegation meeting, a proposed local bill was introduced by Representative Elizabeth Fetterhoff that will benefit the City of Daytona Beach. Senator Travis Hutson will be the bill’s Senate sponsor.

The Legislative Delegation gave its unanimous support to the bill. This legislation, if approved would release state owned rights and restrictions to property along the Daytona Beach riverfront to the City at no cost to the City.

Release of the State restrictions has been approved by the Florida Cabinet contingent on payment by the City of an amount in excess of \$8.7 million. The City Commission adopted its 2018-2019 legislative priority list on December 5 and Commission approval for adding this item to the City’s priority list is requested. This action is requested at the December 19, 2018 City Commission meeting.
