BACKGROUND: <u>By Resolution No. 18-249, the City retained attorney Michael Kahn to draft new panhandling regulations and to conduct evidentiary hearings before the City Commission in support thereof. Evidentiary hearings were conducted on December 12, 2018 and January 16, 2019. Attorney Kahn is now proposing that the City adopt an Ordinance amending the City Code to provide new panhandling regulations including sections for findings and intent, definitions, prohibited conduct, and proximity and location restrictions for panhandlers, beggars, and solicitors.</u>
