<p>BACKGROUND: <u>Utilities Department requests the City Commission adopt a resolution approving the following:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>A Continuing Services Contract for cured-in-place-pipe rehabilitation to Insituform Technologies, LLC, 17988 Edison Avenue, Chesterfield, MO 63005.</u> • <u>The Contract term for one year with the option to renew the Contract on a yearly basis consistent with the Contract’s four one-year renewals option.</u> • <u>The City Manager’s authority to renew the Contract annually under the Contract’s renewal option.</u> <p><u>This request is needed to provide the City with rapid access to reliable and high quality pipe lining services needed for stormwater and sanitary sewer pipe improvement projects, as they are identified, in order to maintain and/or improve system capacity and reliability.</u></p> <p><u>Cured-In-Place-Pipe rehabilitation provides the City with an alternative to traditional open excavation re-construction. It is a cost effective method for strengthening and extending the useful life of aging and deteriorated pipe. The cured-in-place-pipe product system is used to structurally enhance existing pipes with the use of water tight internal linings while causing minimal or no surface disruption to roadways, residential neighborhoods and commercial facilities.</u></p> <p><u>The City issued Request for Proposals No. 0118-2600 on August 28, 2018, to obtain a Contractor to provide cured-in-place-pipe rehabilitation services for damaged and deteriorated sanitary sewer and storm water pipe. The following five Contractors submitted proposals:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Evans Contracting Services, Inc. 320 Foxtail Ave. Middleburg, Fl 32086</u> • <u>Granite Inliner, 2531 Jewett Lane, Sanford, Fl 32771</u> • <u>Hinterland Group, Inc. 2051 W. Blue Heron Blvd, Riviera Beach, Fl 33404</u> • <u>Insituform Technologies, LLC, 17988 Edison Avenue, Chesterfield, MO 63005</u> • <u>Vacvision Environmental, LLC, 10200 US Hwy 92 E., Tampa, Fl 33610</u> <p><u>In accordance with the City’s Purchasing Code, a selection committee evaluated and ranked the five proposals. The City’s selection committee ranked the firms and Insituform Technologies, LLC was ranked the highest based on their experience. There is no City funding associated with this request.</u></p>
